Philip and Peter,

I had a discussion with our signal group regarding the signals along Route 208 and we have determined the following.

- NYSDOT will request that the Neelytown Business Park project upgrade our signal detections at the two ramps to I-84(O-169,O-170) and the intersection of Route 298/Hawkins (O-178). Talking with our signal group we ask that radar detection be installed at each signal.
- Regarding adjusting the signal timing. NYSDOT will work with our consultant AKRF with calibrating the coordinated adaptive system.
